The K-12 program focuses on teaching methodologies rooted in Grammar, Logic and Rhetoric. The span of our curriculum across these grade levels include:

- Reading / Literature
- English Grammar

- Latin (3rd – 12th)
- Logic (7th – 9th)



Philosophy of Christian Education

1. All knowledge and wisdom begins and ends with God.
